Councilman Mark Conway Joins Us

- Conway is chair of the Public Safety Committee. Group violence prevention has been rolled out once before and is back in action. This prevention strategy has proven to lower crime in its implementation in the past. Conway has been meeting with the program staff monthly for the last year and the program has lowered crime in the western district. Conway acknowledges an increase in violent crime in the northeast district and over the year BCPD has made some progress, but he has particularly been leaning in on progress in the NE.
- Conway discusses Police Accountability Board that has civilian oversight of BCPD.
- Conway discusses York Rd business improvement district to improve the York Rd Corridor. The corridor spans from 42nd street to Northern Parkway.
- Conway discusses the Condition of Idlewood
 - Street Light Upgrade for Idlewood has been initiated, but not completed. A lot of light poles do not have LED bulbs and the conversion has stopped.
 - Conway will follow up with DOT and cc ICA on the email to see that all lights are updated.
- Conway discusses the parking conditions in Idlewood and advises to call 311 and send the complaint number to info.ica21239@gmail.com for tracking. There is a possibility to issue fines for cars parked for 48 hours, residents with cones in front of homes, but this is not always easy to enforce. Parking Permits were discussed as a solution for Idlewood.
- Conway discusses the condition of homes that are not properly maintained. The low maintained homes are an issue and should be reported to 311 and send the complaint number to info.ica21239@gmail.com for tracking. In some cases the Department of the Environment and City Housing department can follow up on complaints and citations.
- Conway emphasizes that bulk trash is active and to let the community know to make their request for pickup via 311. Conway discussed the idea of having street sweepers return to the community. The City is slowly reinstating street sweeping.

Community Concerns.

- We need a secretary for the community. The President discussed the need to have more community members on board with ICA and help out with future activities.
- Budget Update. The current balance for the community account is \$12,599.00
- The Idlewood Update will go out and provide need to know information as well as meeting notes from the previous executive board meeting.
